ENTRY INFORMATION

- All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms or via LabTestedOnline (www.labtestedonline.com). **PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY;** illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to exhibitor
- During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: 30% online per day; 70% paper entries per day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly
- Checks or money orders only; made payable to “RDOC”; No Cash
- Entries without fees will not be accepted

- One dog per entry form. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend
- Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable; the agreement must be signed
- Entries are not accepted via email, telephone or FAX
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed in full
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$30.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks
- Overpayments of less than \$10 will not be refunded
- Express/Overnight/Certified mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address without signature
- Limit 10 entries per envelope
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form** must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. .

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations

CONFIRMATIONS

Entries will be acknowledged and a Final Confirmation/Judging Schedule will be sent by email unless specifically requested otherwise. In which case they will be sent by US mail only. If you have not received a Final Confirmation by five days before the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

WAITLIST

A wait list will be maintained for these trials. The wait list will be active until Monday, September 14, 2026, at 6:00 pm. Individual run entries pulled after closing but before the wait list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the wait list. The exhibitor will be reimbursed for the number of runs replaced. If a run is pulled, but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be marked absent. Fees for entries remaining on the waitlist after the waitlist deadline will be refunded in full (or checks returned/destroyed) on or after the trial date.

This is the expected running order. In the event it needs to be re-evaluated and changed, we will notify entered exhibitors. Walk-throughs will be announced in judging schedule distributed after closing.

FEO RUNS (For Exhibition Only) ARE OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

**24-Inch Choice: Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion if their measurement is 22 inches and under at the withers. Dogs who measure into the 24-inch regular jump height division are not eligible to enter 24-inch Choice.

JUMP HEIGHT CARD and MEASURING

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete, but they must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog measured by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

MOVE-UP POLICY

Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted in writing (email preferred, no texts or IMs) to the Trial Secretary by Monday, September 14, 2026, at 6pm. Please use the name and date of the trial in the subject. Include your dog's call name and the from/to move-up classes.

Day-to-day lateral moves and move-downs are now included in the rules for move-ups, as defined in Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials and will be allowed at this trial. The phrase, "as a result of qualifying for an agility title" shall be removed from the section. Owners may move their dog at their discretion; no title is required. However, to acquire legs, dogs must be moved to a class for which they are eligible, or they will need to run FEO. Request for day-to-day moves must be in writing on the form provided and received by the Trial Secretary within 15 minutes of the last class of the day.

RIBBONS & AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue
Second Place	Red
Third Place	Yellow
Fourth Place	White
Qualifying Score	Flat Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette and MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH. A Agility Grand Champion (AGCH) rosette and bar will be given to those earning this title at the trial. Double "Q" ribbons will be given to those earning a "QQ" in Master classes the same day. A "Perfect Score" ribbon will be given to those in Novice, Open, and Excellent classes who qualify with a score of 100 points. All ribbons and awards must be claimed by the end of the Trial; none will be mailed.

OBSTACLES, RING CONDITIONS, WALK-THROUGH & WARM-UP

Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the *Regulations for Agility Trials*. "Clip n Go" rubberized contacts will be used. All classes will take place on an artificial turf surface. Ring size will be 78' x 120'. Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to ONLY handlers entered in that class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving the dog.

SITE INFORMATION

No Exhibitor Setup prior to Saturday

Crating: All dogs in the crating areas must be in wire crates, or portable soft crates that have four sides, top and bottom, with zippered closures. X-pens are not allowed at this trial. Priority will be given to volunteer workers. If space is available non-workers may also crate inside. The inner crating room is restricted to club officials only.

Leashes: All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. Snap, martingale, and slip-leads are allowed. Flexi-leads must be kept to 3ft or shorter and locked when inside or outside in the potty area.

Shoes: Handlers need shoes with low traction to avoid "sticking" to the turf. Trail shoes do not work well. Please choose something with less tread.

All **turf accidents** must be reported immediately and a \$10 clean up fee has to be paid by the exhibitor to Level Up Dog Sports.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

As of January 3, 2024, Clubs holding agility trials will be required to offer Fix and Go On for all classes. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

FEO will be offered in all classes at this trial

FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying and will be marked as "absent" in the catalog.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed
- The exhibitor must declare FEO to the scribe and the judge in the ring prior to leading out
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST course times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations
- Toys are allowed in the ring; Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand; Toys that roll freely may not be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring nor any toy designed to hold food/treats
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

AKC AGILITY REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are encouraged to obtain a copy of the *Regulations for Agility Trials* by downloading from the American Kennel Club website at www.akc.org

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No class will be delayed by a late exhibitor. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during walkthroughs. All dogs must be on leash or secured in their crate except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc. Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner/Handler is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

REFUNDS for BIS, INJURY

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in AKC Agility Trials. As such, the Club will refund all but \$5 per run of the entry fee paid, for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial. The Club will refund all but \$10 per run of the entry fee for injured dogs upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

VOLUNTEERS

Those volunteering to work one class may crate inside the building for that day.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program™** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
